



Thai Public Broadcasting Service Announcement  
on Declaring the Intention to Avoid Accepting Gifts for Duty Performance (No Gift Policy)  
Fiscal Year 2024 (B.E. 2567)

---

Thai Public Broadcasting Service (Thai PBS), as a public service and public media organization, operates through a comprehensive and balanced variety of service channels, strictly in adherence to media professional ethics, and focuses primarily on public interest. This aligns with the objectives outlined in the Thai Public Broadcasting Service Act, B.E. 2551 (2008).

To prevent offenses and breaches related to conflicts of interest between personal and public benefits, as stipulated in Section 128 of the Organic Act on Prevention and Suppression of Corruption, B.E. 2561 (2018), and to promote values of integrity in performing duty, characterized by morality, ethics, and transparency, with this, Thai PBS states its intent for awareness among individuals, agencies, and the public as follows:

1. All executives and personnel of Thai PBS shall not receive any gifts or gratuities of any kind in the course of, prior to, or following their duties, which could lead to corruption and improper conduct, both in the present and future. This also includes adherence to the National Anti-Corruption Commission's announcement on the Guidelines for Receiving Assets or Other Benefits Under the Official's Ethical Conduct, B.E. 2563 (2020).
2. Expressions of congratulations, and well wishes on various occasions should be conveyed through social media instead of giving gifts or gratuities.
3. All personnel of Thai PBS are obliged to inform external parties about this policy thoroughly.
